

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?



Final tryout results will be posted on the LCU website www.lcusoccer.org on June 14th (per New WYSA guidelines). Player's tryout numbers and initials will be posted for the various age groups & teams. WYSA now requires written acceptance of placement; your online registration will be your written electronic acceptance of placement. Acceptance of your placement and completion of online registration of your player must occur within 72 hours of the June 14th posting of placement notification.

If your child is selected, you and your child will need to attend a team meeting at Merton Intermediate School. For teams U15-U18 you will be informed of team meeting dates at tryouts.

At tryouts you were given an informational statement regarding the teams at specific age levels which provided an estimate/outline regarding team expenses & training/tournament participation. This was meant to provide a projection of anticipated activities but may not be all inclusive and is subject to coach discretion. At the team meeting you will be provided further information regarding LCU Club policies and coach expectations for practices and games, tournaments your team will participate in, as well as uniform sizing and purchase. **A parent/guardian must accompany the player to the meeting.** This is an opportunity to meet your team mates and ask questions prior to the start of the season. Your group and team meeting will take approximately 90 minutes overall.

*****You will need to bring a 1x1 inch photo of your child** (no larger or it will not fit on the player card) and your child will need to sign a signature label at the team meeting to create their player card.

At the team meeting you will need to bring your check book to cover the following:

- Respective registration fee: U11/U12 is \$210; U13/U14 is \$270 which includes fall & spring agility training; U15-U18 \$220 which includes agility training for their respective season.
- Volunteer Deposit \$200 (**to be returned upon completion of your volunteer hours)
- Coach's fee (**fall fees collected at this meeting; spring fee will be due April 1st)
- Tournament registration fee
(**fall season tournament fee collected at this meeting; spring tournament fees collected generally around February)
- Uniforms ordering/purchase
- Fundraiser contribution

***Our fee structure at LCU includes a \$60 fundraising commitment (up to a maximum commitment per family of 2 players/\$120). It can be earned back through the sale of raffle tickets that you will receive in early fall (you can either sell the tickets you receive or can use them yourself).

Where Do My Fees Go?

Your LCU Registration fees cover various expenses the club must cover to run a successful, safe program.

Fees help to cover the following:

- WYSA administration fees (insurance, US Youth Soccer Association Membership, player registration)
- Ref Fees (U11-U18 center and 2 side ref fees which increase with the age group for each game played during a season)
- Field Rental (LCU does not own the fields—Our goal is to eventually obtain land to create an ideal layout for fields to suit the needs of players from U5 to U18)
- Field Maintenance (Grass cutting, field striping (paint))
- Equipment (field flags, goals, nets, port-o-john rental, etc)
